Abstract of DE10137467 (A1)

The woven silk fabric, especially woven in a Habotai silk style, has warps (1) and wefts (2) of silk with identical characteristics. Selected warps (1') and/or wefts (2') are structured at intervals of 2-6 mm and preferably 3-5 mm. The woven silk fabric, especially woven in a Habotai silk style, has warps (1) and wefts (2) of silk with identical characteristics. Selected warps (1') and/or wefts (2') are structured at intervals of 2-6 mm and preferably 3-5 mm. These structured yarns are doubled, tripled or quadrupled, or they are of thicker silk yarns with an increased thread count. Or these structured yarns can be synthetic.
